Using innovative technology that measures the language environment, educators will learn strategies to improve the quantity and quality of interactions in support of the language development of infants and toddlers. Providers who complete all 16 hours of training and complete all class expectations will receive a \$200 stipend.</i></p>

While the focus is on children with developmental delays, the strategies are relevant for all children.</i></p>
